Bridges Requirements

1. Complete the 12 credit hours below at JCTC or another KCTCS school with a grade of "C" or higher.

- ENG 101* (3)
- 100-level math* (3)
- PSY 110 (3)
- COM 181 (3)



2. Earn a cumulative 2.0 or higher GPA on a 4.0 scale.

Please note, selective admission programs may have higher standards.

*These courses may require remedial coursework.
